GENERAL FINANCIAL AID

The Office of Financial Aid reserves the right on behalf of the college to review and cancel awards if there is a change in financial or academic status, change of address, change in enrollment or status, reduction of available funds, or if the award is not accepted by the student on the college's behalf in the award package or because of the recipient's failure to observe the college's admission requirements.

It is the policy of the college to disburse one-half of the awards (excluding work-study awards) after the drop date each semester, provided the student's file is complete. Disbursements of financial aid are generally made in the form of a direct credit to the student's account. Full-time students will receive a direct credit to their account.
